OUR COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAMS & SERVICES

Emergency/Trauma Services

Our state-designated Level II Adult Trauma Center, one of only three in metro Atlanta, is well-staffed with board-certified emergency medicine physicians and nurses holding a variety of emergency certifications. The 15,000-square-foot emergency area incorporates 28 patient rooms, including separate cardiac, trauma and orthopedic areas equipped with modern and sophisticated equipment to handle situations ranging from minor emergencies to life-threatening traumas.

Women's Services

North Fulton Regional Hospital offers services designed with women in mind for all the stages of her life, from obstetrics to gynecology, young ladies to mature women. Our service offerings include hospital services, outpatient diagnostics and more. Receive family-centered care your way through our maternity services. Experience convenient and comfortable imaging services through our Women's Imaging Center that includes mammography, ultrasound, breast biopsy, bone densitometry and general radiology. 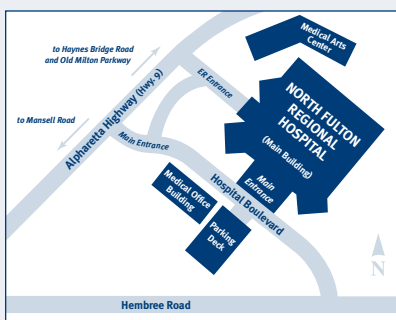
Rehabilitation
